ROAD OF TRADITIONS AND NATURE

The traditional way of life in the Pyrenees is about to disappear because of the phenomenon of depopulation and of the social changes. Soon, all the persons that know and make some costumes already living will disappear.

The Road of Traditions and Nature is an invitation to know the traditional culture and the privileged natural environment of the territory, with one of the largest protected area of the European Union.

Situated in the southern slope of the Central Pyrenees, in Sobrarbe there are the National Park Of Ordesa and Monte Perdido, as well as a part of the Natural Parks of Posets-Maladeta, of the Sierra and Canyons of Guara.

The axis of the rivers Cinca and Ara structure this unique space in which in a radius of a 30 km there are 19 museums, permanent expositions and itineraries about traditions (in blue) and about nature (in green) in this territory with pronounced character.

This is an opportunity to know in an entertaining way the everyday life, the legends and believes, the traditional arts and occupations, the constructions and their integration in the nature.

Aínsa presents one of the most interesting ethnologic collections of the Pyrenees on the traditional arts and occupations.

On the 4 floors of this building of the 16th century situated in the historical centre of Aínsa, we discover the blacksmith workshop, with the anvil and other skills; the wood and its production cycle; the sawmill, the carpenter workshop, a handsome loom and the textiles made on hemp and wool; the traditional pottery, the work on the tin plate and the fabrication of the baskets.

An indispensable visit to know the traditional occupations and the everyday utensils that define the life in the mountains and the valleys.

The photographic archives on the everyday life aspects in the first part of the past century, and the large panels on the fauna and the flora, the traditional gastronomy and clothing, permit to know the idiosyncrasy of this singular village.

Thanks to the staging of sounds and lights, we are plunged in a festive bustle of the famous carnival of Bielsa, inhabited by characters full of symbolisms and tradition.

The section on the Spanish Civil War remembers the episodes of the Pocket of Bielsa thanks to a film and some objects used during the battle, showing this way the marks of a part of our recent History.

The lammergeyer is a bird of three-meters wide, that is in danger of extinction and whose major population lives in the Pyrenees.

The Fundación para la Protección del Quebrantahuesos pretends to spread in an easy and didactical way the most surprising values of the fauna and the nature of the Pyrenees, thanks to scale models, inter-active and audiovisual games.

The refuge of the fauna offers a guided visit on the birds of prey, that cannot live in a savage state, dealing with their surprising biology, their questions, and the important efforts that are realised for the conservation of the unique bird in the world that eats bones.

It is also possible to find information about the natural values and the protected spaces in the Pyrenees and have the possibility to visit the natural environment with a guide.

The navatas were rafts made of trunk and that were used until the middle of the 20th century as away to transport wood to the delta of the Ebre.

In the museum of the wood, there are axes and other skills that give a proof of the use of the wood from the forests.

In Ceresa, the exposition gives information on the traditional way of life and on the exploitation of the wood trough indicated routes.

Ecomuseum Luis Pallaruelo - Laspuña Network of Routes of the Nature Laspuña-Ceresa Ethnobotanic Route Escalona-Puyarruego

The route of the Ecomuseum Luis Pallaruelo leads to Laspuña until the river Cinca, the route finishing with the scale reconstruction of a raft.

The Routes of the Nature are a network in the mountain with panels that give explanations and information on the environment.

The Ethnobotanic Route between Escalona and Puyarruego gives information on the traditional use of the plants and the trees of these lands.


